The Texas music scene has always had a mentality to call its own. They have their own charts, their own artists, and if no one outside of Texas ever pays much attention to them they are just fine with that because in the state of Texas they are all superstars ~ With his debut single "Take The L Out of Lover," newcomer Jeremy Phifer sets out on the path to becoming the next sought after Texas based artist. The tempo driven song laced with shredding guitar sings of the final stages of a relationship gone wrong as he uses broken hearted lyrics like "wasted memories and sleepless nights" to hammer home the point that got them to where they are. He uses these types of descriptions throughout the verses to lead into the chorus where we get the incredible hook of "Take The L Out of Lover and It's Over." The lyrics are crafted in such a way that you nearly leap out of your seat to give the songwriting craft used here a standing ovation. Phifer creates the atmosphere of the song perfectly and hits any listener that has gone through a break-up right in the heart. His raw, southern rock tinged vocals are enticing and wrap around the lyrics perfectly adding an element of depth to the believability of the song. If this is just the start for Phifer then I personally cannot wait to see what comes.
